## Notice of the 115th Annual General Meeting

## Notice is hereby given

that the 115th Annual General Meeting of the Institution of Structural Engineers will be held online\* on Thursday 11 July 2024 at midday (GMT) for the transaction, by Voting Members, of the business set out below:

- 1. To read the notice convening the meeting.
- 2. To read, confirm and sign the minutes of the General Meeting held on 20 July 2023 (published in The Structural Engineer, September 2023).
- 3. To receive the financial statements and balance sheet for the year 2023, together with the auditors' report thereon, and the report of the Trustee Board for 2023.
- 4. To appoint auditors for the ensuing year and to fix their remuneration. (The Board recommends Haysmacintyre chartered accountants and registered auditors, at a fee to be agreed with them by the Board).
- 5. To consider and, if thought fit, to adopt the following motion:

THAT, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 3.1, and in confirmation of proposals of the Board, annual subscriptions with effect from 1 January 2025, and until otherwise determined, shall be:

Incorporated-Member	£ 256
Technician-Member	£ 199
Graduate, Companion, Student (working)	£ 192

The annual subscriptions for 2025 represent a 3% increase on the subscription rates for 2024.

Explanatory Note 1 – Standing Order 5.1 defines a 'meeting' as in addition to a physical assembly of members of a body, a meeting shall include the organised interaction of its members by means of telephone or audio conferencing or by electronic means, or by means of any other form of technology whether in existence at the coming into effect of these standing orders or not.

Explanatory Note 2 – Regulation 5.7.1 defines 'Voting Member' as a Chartered or an Incorporated Structural Engineer or Asociate or a Technician Member or a Graduate whose subscription and other membership payments have been paid.

Explanatory Note 4 – Under Regulation 5.8, unless a poll is demanded, a motion put to the vote of the meeting shall be decided on a show of hands by a majority of the Voting Members present in person and voting.

Explanatory Note 5 – In accordance with Regulation 5.3, only the business specified in this notice may be considered at the meeting.

Explanatory Note 6 – The rates of subscription paid by retired members are set by the Board under Regulation 3.5. The rates for 2025 will be: Retired Fellow with The Structural Engineer £101; Retired other grades with The Structural Engineer £84, Retired without The Structural Engineer £44.
